54 So <u>when this corruptible</u> has <u>put on incorruption</u>, and <u>this mortal</u> has <u>put</u> <u>on immortality</u>, <u>then shall be brought to pass</u> the <u>saying</u> that is <u>written</u>: "**Death is swallowed up in victory**."

Let us close with one of my most favorite scriptures,

Revelation 21:3-4

3 And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, <u>the tabernacle</u> of <u>God</u> is <u>with men</u>, and <u>He will dwell</u> with <u>them</u>, and <u>they</u> shall be <u>His people</u>. <u>God Himself</u> will <u>be</u> with <u>them</u> and <u>be</u> their <u>God</u>.

4 And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more

<u>death</u>, nor <u>sorrow</u>, nor <u>crying</u>. There shall be <u>no more pain</u>, for the former things have <u>passed away</u>."
