17 And <u>these signs</u> will <u>follow those who believe</u>: <u>In My name</u> they will <u>cast out demons</u>; they will <u>speak with new tongues</u>;

18 they will **take up serpents**; and if they **drink anything deadly**, it will by **no means hurt them**; they will **lay hands on the sick**, and they **will recover**."

It is our legal right!

Romans 6:5-7

5 For <u>if we have been united together in the likeness of His death</u> (at baptism), certainly <u>we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection</u> (He is

not the property of Satan, so we are not either),

6 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him (we are no longer sin natured Adam), that the body of sin might be done away with (through our death), that we should no longer be slaves of sin (but resurrected to newness of life and freedom from the enemy).

7 For <u>he who has died</u> has been <u>freed from sin</u>. (Satan has no legal right to us. He can only enter through sin, and if we walk in repentance, the blood of Jesus covers us. Sin has no hold on the born again.)

So we truly understand, let me say again, Jesus agreed to die at the hand of Satan through the people of that age to set all of creation free. He did that, He paid the price, He kept the bargain. Now we can be born again and enter into this new covenant as Abraham's seed, seal our position at communion and once again be legal heirs to this planet and all on it.

Galatians 3:27-29

- 27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.
- 28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
- 29 And <u>if you are Christ's</u>, then <u>you are Abraham's seed</u>, and <u>heirs according to the promise</u>.

Not only that, we legally are of the household of God with our new birth, and have the legal right to the family name of Jesus that has all authority over the enemy.

Ephesians 2:19 tells us:

19 Now, therefore, <u>you</u> are <u>no longer strangers and foreigners</u>, but <u>fellow</u> <u>citizens</u> with the <u>saints</u> and <u>members of the household of God</u>,

Philippians 2:10 explains the authority in our family name:

10 that <u>at the name of Jesus</u> <u>every knee should bow</u>, of <u>those in heaven</u>, and of <u>those on earth</u>, and of <u>those under the earth</u>,

Look at **John 14:14**

14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

And remember what we read in Mark 16:17.

Mark 16:17

17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;

Satan and his wicked hosts of darkness, even his principalities and powers, have to release us on command through the authority of that name! Really think about this, let it sink in. Get angry even, for not being told before now of your rights.

Galatians 4:1&7

1 Now <u>I say</u> that <u>the heir</u>, as <u>long</u> as he is <u>a child</u>, does not <u>differ</u> at <u>all</u> from a <u>slave</u>, <u>though</u> <u>he is master of all</u>,

7 Therefore <u>you</u> are <u>no longer a slave</u> but <u>a son</u>, and <u>if a son</u>, then <u>an heir of</u>
<u>God</u> through <u>Christ</u>.

Now look at these scriptures and see our obligation to grow and mature, to take advantage of what Jesus really accomplished for all of creation on the cross. He came to set the captives free!

Romans 8:19-21

19 For the <u>earnest expectation</u> of the <u>creation</u> <u>eagerly waits</u> for the <u>revealing</u> of the <u>sons of God</u> (we have been as slaves).

20 For the <u>creation</u> was <u>subjected</u> to <u>futility</u>, <u>not willingly</u>, but <u>because of</u> <u>Him who subjected it in hope</u> (in hope that man would understand His plan and execute it);

21 <u>because</u> the <u>creation itself</u> <u>also</u> <u>will be delivered</u> from <u>the bondage of</u> <u>corruption</u> into the <u>glorious liberty</u> of <u>the children of God</u>.

This is the most serious subject or topic we will ever contemplate. It's "life" or death! Are you experiencing defeat in your life? Are you in bondage to drugs, cigarettes, food etc? Do you walk in fear, sickness, poverty, depression, anger? Is your marriage on the rocks, your children causing you grief? Do you want to know God better and walk a victorious walk?
